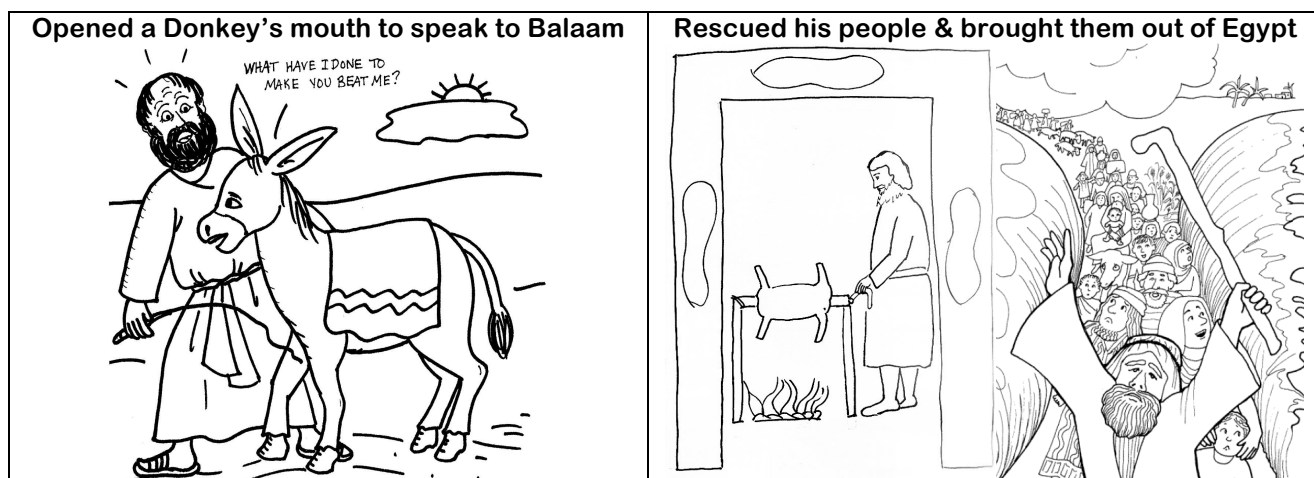
## The Last Supper

*Matthew 26:17-30, Luke 22:7-38, John 13:1-30*

It was the Festival of Unleavened Bread – what is this also called?

*(Hint – Luke Chapter 22 v.1)*

This is a festival celebrated by the Jewish people to remember the time when God did something, what was it? **(Circle the right answer)**



Jesus said to his disciples “ Go and make preparations for us to eat the Passover.”

“Where do you want us to prepare for it?” they asked.

What happened next? **(Cross out the wrong answer in the brackets)**

He replied, “As you enter the **(city/matrix)**, a man carrying a jar of **(water/orange juice)** will meet you. Follow him to the **(stables/house)** that he enters, and say to the **(owner/servants)** of the house, ‘The Teacher asks: Where is the **(games/guest)** room, where I may eat the **(Big Mac/Passover)** with my disciples?’ He will show you a **(large/antiquated)** room upstairs, all furnished. Make **(hay/preparations)** there.”

They left and **(found/jumped on)** things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the **(Birthday cake/Passover)**.

When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. And he said to them, “I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God.”

*(Luke Chapter 22 v.7-16)*

## Beginners/Pioneers Supplementary page

### Chat with your parents/caregiver

- Have you been in a Church service when they do the Lords Supper, can you remember some of the things said and done? If you haven't seen or can't remember ask your caregiver to describe it to you.

In today's story we see why Jesus said to do all of this in remembrance of him. But Jesus was doing more than saying to eat bread and drink wine. He was talking about how his body would be given and his blood poured out.

- Can you remember what he said this would achieve? (Hint – remember what we learnt from Matthew Ch.26 v.28)

We'll see on Sunday exactly how Jesus did this, and what it meant for his body to be given and his blood to be poured out when he goes to the cross, and just how important it is for everyone!

**Thank God that Jesus was willing to have his body broken and his blood poured out for us, and help us to always remember what he did for us!**



## Explorers Supplementary page

### Have a think/chat with your parents/caregiver

- What event do you think Jesus was talking about when he said his body would be given and his blood poured out? (Hint – think about what we remember especially today – Good Friday)
- What did Jesus doing this achieve? And so why do you think today is often referred to as '**Good Friday**'? (Hint – remember what we learnt from Matthew Ch.26 v.28)

In fact the forgiveness of sins for many is *exactly* why Jesus came down from heaven to earth. This was God's big plan from the beginning!

- Why do you think the gospel writers think it is very important that we know that the Last Supper was taking place during the Passover? (Hint – think about what God did in the Passover, and what God was doing through his Son Jesus now)

### Let's pray!

Lets thank God for choosing to rescue his people, through his Son Jesus. Let us remember how we are forgiven – through Jesus' body being given and his blood being poured out. Let us put our trust in Jesus and ask for forgiveness for the wrong things that we have done.

## Scripture Passages

<sup>17</sup> On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Where do you want us to make preparations for you to eat the Passover?"

<sup>18</sup> He replied, "Go into the city to a certain man and tell him, 'The Teacher says: My appointed time is near. I am going to celebrate the Passover with my disciples at your house.'" <sup>19</sup> So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them and prepared the Passover.

<sup>20</sup> When evening came, Jesus was reclining at the table with the Twelve. <sup>21</sup> And while they were eating, he said, "Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me."

<sup>22</sup> They were very sad and began to say to him one after the other, "Surely you don't mean me, Lord?"

<sup>23</sup> Jesus replied, "The one who has dipped his hand into the bowl with me will betray me. <sup>24</sup> The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born."

<sup>25</sup> Then Judas, the one who would betray him, said, "Surely you don't mean me, Rabbi?" Jesus answered, "You have said so."

<sup>26</sup> While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body."

<sup>27</sup> Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. <sup>28</sup> This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. <sup>29</sup> I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom."

<sup>30</sup> When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

*(Matthew Ch.26 v.27-28)*

<sup>7</sup> Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. <sup>8</sup> Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, "Go and make preparations for us to eat the Passover."

<sup>9</sup> "Where do you want us to prepare for it?" they asked.

<sup>10</sup> He replied, "As you enter the city, a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him to the house that he enters, <sup>11</sup> and say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher asks: Where is the guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?' <sup>12</sup> He will show you a large room upstairs, all furnished. Make preparations there."

<sup>13</sup> They left and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.

<sup>14</sup> When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. <sup>15</sup> And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. <sup>16</sup> For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God."

<sup>17</sup> After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. <sup>18</sup> For I tell you I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."

<sup>19</sup> And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

<sup>20</sup> In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you. <sup>21</sup> But the hand of him who is going to betray me is with mine on the table. <sup>22</sup> The Son of Man will go as it has been decreed. But woe to that man who betrays him!" <sup>23</sup> They began to question among themselves which of them it might be who would do this.

*(Luke Ch.22 v.21-23)*

<sup>21</sup> After he had said this, Jesus was troubled in spirit and testified, "Very truly I tell you, one of you is going to betray me."

<sup>22</sup> His disciples stared at one another, at a loss to know which of them he meant. <sup>23</sup> One of them, the disciple whom Jesus loved, was reclining next to him. <sup>24</sup> Simon Peter motioned to this disciple and said, "Ask him which one he means."

<sup>25</sup> Leaning back against Jesus, he asked him, "Lord, who is it?"

<sup>26</sup> Jesus answered, "It is the one to whom I will give this piece of bread when I have dipped it in the dish." Then, dipping the piece of bread, he gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot. <sup>27</sup> As soon as Judas took the bread, Satan entered into him.

So Jesus told him, "What you are about to do, do quickly." <sup>28</sup> But no one at the meal understood why Jesus said this to him. <sup>29</sup> Since Judas had charge of the money, some thought Jesus was telling him to buy what was needed for the festival, or to give something to the poor. <sup>30</sup> As soon as Judas had taken the bread, he went out. And it was night.

*(John Ch. 13 v.21-30)*

<sup>16</sup> And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever—<sup>17</sup> the Spirit of truth.
