

- What should we do when we hear Jesus' words?




Can you think of ways – perhaps from previous weeks – that we can do what Jesus says?

Jesus speaks to us through the Bible, through what the disciples, Jesus' witnesses, empowered by the Holy Spirit, have recorded about what Jesus said and did.


